WyARNG hosts monthly memorial for veterans in November

CHEYENNE – A state-wide effort to help bring closure to families who lost a veteran began in June with monthly memorial services conducted by the Wyoming Army National Guard's Honor Guard Team, in partnership with the Wyoming Veterans Commission.

The next ceremony will be held at the Uinta County Complex, 225 9th St., in Evanston, on Nov. 30, at noon, with participation from Evanston American Legion Post 41, Evanston VFW Post 4280, Fort Bridger, and Lyman, Mt. View VFW Post 7798 members and the Wyoming Army National Guard Honor Guard. The public is encouraged to attend.

The goal is to provide military honors to a larger number of deserving Wyoming veterans.

The service opens with the Pledge of Allegiance, a prayer, the reading of the names of the Wyoming veterans who died during the month, a rifle volley, the playing of "Taps" and the folding of the U.S. flag.

The Wyoming Army National Guard provides free military honors for veterans' individual services; however, some veterans, for one reason or another, never receive the honors due.
