Camp Guernsey recognized for cultural resources management

CHEYENNE – The Wyoming Army National Guard's Camp Guernsey recently won the fiscal year 2009 Secretary of the Army award for cultural resources management on an installation.

The camp was recognized for the efforts of its cultural resources management office in researching, preserving and collecting data from historic sites as an integral part of enhancing the installation's primary mission as a field artillery training center.

An independent panel of judges made up of professionals from federal, state and Army organizations recommended the Wyoming Army Guard for the award. The Secretary of the Army Environmental Awards represent the highest honor in the field of environmental science and sustainability conferred by the Army.

Camp Guernsey will go on to compete in the cultural resources management category at the Secretary of Defense Environmental Awards later this year.

Wyoming Army Guard representatives from the cultural resources management office, command staff and Camp Guernsey, will accept the award within Building 106, at Camp Guernsey at 2:30 p.m., on April 14.
