### WWII honor flight farewell ceremony

CASPER – The public is invited to a community farewell ceremony for Wyoming's World War II veterans at 7:45 a.m., on Sept. 21, at the Casper/Natrona County International Airport observation deck.

Honor Flight Wyoming is sending a group of Wyoming's World War II veterans on a two-day trip to Washington, D.C., Sept. 21-22.

Gov. Freudenthal and other dignitaries will speak at the farewell ceremony.

A charter aircraft will carry more than 160 veterans, guardians, and staff to visit the memorials in Washington, D.C.

The first three hours of parking at the airport is free, overnight parking fees are being waived for Honor Flight Wyoming Guardians, staff, and veterans.

The public is also invited to join the welcome home corridor inside the Casper/Natrona County International Airport terminal at about 8:30 p.m. on Sept. 22.
