## WyYCP hosts Guernsey Haunted House

GUERNSEY – The Wyoming Youth ChalleNGe Program and a local civic group known as the “Beehive” will host the Guernsey Haunted House on Oct. 29, from 7-9 p.m. and Oct. 30, from 7-10 p.m. at the Guernsey VFW Hall, located at 42 S. Idaho Ave.

Admission will be a non-perishable food item or a cash donation of \$2 per person to benefit local churches that give food baskets for the holidays.

Wyoming Youth ChalleNGe cadets perform a minimum of 50 hours of community service during their five month residential phase of the program.

The Wyoming Youth ChalleNGe Program provides Wyoming youth, ages 16-18, who have dropped out of high school, a chance to work toward their GED. Cadets begin the program with a five-month residency program at the program’s campus at the Wyoming National Guard’s Camp Guernsey Joint Training Center. The program incorporates scholastic studies with life skills courses and mentorship. Program graduates are provided mentors and receive help in finding employment or enrolling into college or trade schools.
