115th Fires Brigade to host open house

The Wyoming Army National Guard's 115th Fires Brigade will conduct an open house May 19, from 1-4 p.m., on the Joint Forces Readiness Center grounds.

"We would like the community to see how we operate in a battlefield environment," said Col. Brian Nesvik, commander of the 115th FiB. "This is an opportunity for the 115th FiB to showcase our equipment and to demonstrate to the community what Wyoming's citizen-soldiers do during a deployment or a state activation."

Parking for the open house will be at the Field Maintenance Shop, accessed from Central Ave. west of Bishop Blvd., in Cheyenne.

The open house is being held during the units' annual training period. This is the first annual training for the brigade since returning from a year-long deployment in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom, last April. The brigade has more than 850 Soldiers in two battalions and two companies around Wyoming.
