84th CST to conduct exercise at Archer Complex

CHEYENNE – The 84th Civil Support Team will conduct a full-scale training exercise at the Archer Complex, in Cheyenne, on June 28, in cooperation with the Laramie County Emergency Management Agency (EMA).

Members of the 84th Civil Support Team will focus on interagency response to terrorist events as the Wyoming National Guard's premier first responder unit. The relationship between the 84th Civil Support Team and civilian first responder agencies is a key component to sustaining Wyoming's robust all-hazards response capabilities, according to Lt. Col. Paul Phillips, 84th CST commander.

The 84th CST will practice conducting assessments, entry operations into a suspected "hot zone", analyze unknown chemicals and provide recommendations to the incident commander from Laramie County EMA.
