## Wyo. veterans and military recognized during UW Cowboy football game

CHEYENNE – The University of Wyoming, in cooperation with the Wyoming Veterans Commission, will pay tribute to Wyoming veterans and current military personnel, during a special pre-game ceremony, on the field at War Memorial Stadium, in Laramie, Sept. 10.

The event is part of the university's annual Military/Veterans Day game. This year's game features the University of Wyoming and Texas State University-San Marcos.

Veterans, from all conflicts and current military personnel, will help form the tunnel through which the Cowboy football team will enter the field. Veterans and current military personnel will meet at the north end zone, at 3:30 p.m., and will be escorted onto the field. Veterans are encouraged to wear hats, shirts and jackets to identify themselves as Veterans.

Those participating must have a ticket to gain admission to the stadium. Veterans qualify for two free tickets from the Wyoming Veterans Commission, 307-472-0212. There is a limited number of those tickets available and are being offered on a first come, first served basis.

Veterans, their families, and guests are also invited to VFW Post 2221, 2142 Garfield St., Laramie, for a complimentary lunch, on game day, hosted by the Wyoming Veterans Commission. Lunch will run from 1-3 p.m.

“What a great way to acknowledge our Wyoming Veterans service and sacrifice,” said Lee Alley, vice chairman of the Wyoming Veterans Commission and a UW graduate. “Veterans will be recognized on the field and we’ll help cheer on the Cowboys as they take the field.”
